



## Downtown Hollywood “For Rent”

Did you know owners of residential and commercial rental property in the City are required to obtain a Business Tax License Receipt, formerly known as an Occupational License, prior to renting the property?



Business Tax License Receipts are issued by the Treasury Division and must be renewed annually. You can obtain additional information by contacting the Treasury Division at (954) 921-3225.

Many homes within in the area are investment properties serving a vital need for rentals in the community. In an ongoing effort to provide a safe and friendly environment for the citizens of Hollywood, I will be checking properties displaying “For Rent” signage to ensure they are in compliance with applicable code requirements. The Treasury Division will assist me with this endeavor. Property owners must maintain a valid Business Tax License Receipt to avoid enforcement action.
